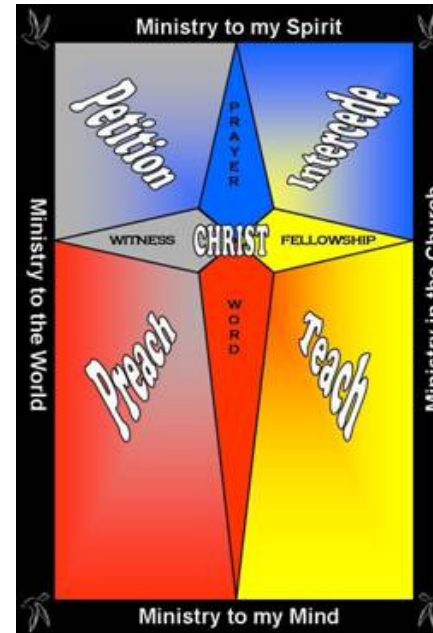

WISE DISCIPLESHIP TRAINING



The WISE (WAC In-house Spiritual Education) program started in 2007 to equip and train members with the fundamentals of doctrine and Christian living. We have ‘evolved’ since then from a lecture based approach to a more hands-on, workshop based experience. This was how WDT (WISE Discipleship Training) was born. It is an intentional discipling program that seeks to equip and empower members to be fruit-bearing disciples.

WDT rests on the twin pillars of bearing the cross (Luke 9:23) and pressing on (Phil 3:13-14). The WDT Disciple’s Cross puts Christ as the center of our lives (Gal 2:20) as we daily die to ourselves, but live for Christ in the areas of Prayer, Fellowship, Word and Witness.

Members begin by learning what discipleship is about and discovering how God has uniquely S.H.A.P.E.d them for Kingdom purposes. Members are not only equipped with evangelism, Bible study and mentoring skills but also practice ‘body living’ through fellowship, accountability sharing, evangelistic outreach and prayer meetings. WDT extends beyond the regular Friday night sessions; it seeks to inculcate godly habits through Bible reading, Scripture memory and journaling.

ELECTORAL ROLL

Question: What is the reason for the prohibition of mixing wool and linen in a garment? (Lev 19:19) Keep my decrees. 'Do not mate different kinds of animals. Do not plant your field with two kinds of seed. Do not wear clothing woven of two kinds of material.'

Answer (Pastor Raymond): The reason is simply unknown, we can only infer from the context. If we cross reference with Deuteronomy: Dt 22:-11 Do not plant two kinds of seed in your vineyard; if you do, not only the crops you plant but also the fruit of the vineyard will be defiled. Do not plow with an ox and a donkey yoked together. Do not wear clothes of wool and linen woven together.

The hint seems to be linked to defilement. It seems the prohibition points to purity and holiness, as the Israelites are to be a people separated for God. What we learn here is that we must be careful to avoid incompatible practices. E.g. Being unequally yoked to an unbeliever or being in partnership that compromises/contradicts our Christian faith and so on.
