Question: What is the reason for the prohibition of mixing wool and linen in a garment? (Lev 19:19)Keep my decrees. ‘Do not mate different kinds of animals. Do not plant your field with two kinds of seed. Do not wear clothing woven of two kinds of material.’

Here are a couple of alternative excerpts from the internet:

1. Talmud points to the story of Cain and Abel: Cain killed Abel after Abel offered sheep - the source of wool - as a sacrifice to God. Cain offered flax, the source of linen. Because the mixture caused humanity's first murder, some posit, it is prohibited.

2. Why? Don't we mix fabrics all of the time?

Several things are going on here; first this is not a prohibition against mixing any two types of material. Some translations say that it is against Gods law to mix two types of fabric. This is NOT the case here. The original text specifically says not to mix Wool and Linen together. Now this does not mean that we can't wear something wool and something separate that is linen. What it is saying is not to weave the two types of threads together to make a garment.
