(Eph 4:14-16, ESV)¹⁴so that we may no longer be children, tossed to and fro by the waves and carried about by every wind of doctrine, by human cunning, by craftiness in deceitful schemes. ¹⁵Rather, speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ, ¹⁶from whom the whole body, joined and held together by every joint with which it is equipped, when each part is working properly, makes the body grow so that it builds itself up in love.

Not all that is preached and taught today in the evangelical churches are sound and balanced. Problem is how can we know the difference? How do we discern and determine the true from the false, the right from the wrong, the balanced from the extremes and distorted. Jesus himself said that false teaching and false teachers will abound in the last days, deceiving many. (Matthew 24:11) We are deceived when we are not even aware we are deceived. Such is the nature of deception that only the trained and alert will be able to detect the phoney. There are some doctrines being taught today that are not really inaccurate but incomplete - leaving out the "other side of the coin".

In view of this current trend the church in her discipling needs to teach, train, and equip all to know how to know the truth. We need to know how to put all that is available to Christians, be it tapes, DVDs, materials found on the internet etc under proper scrutiny and analysis. We need to be like the Bereans in the book of Acts who took the trouble to examine to see that what they have heard is truly the sound Word of God.

If we do not develop that mindset and discipline then we run into the danger mentioned by Paul in Ephesians 4. We will be like gullible children “tossed to and fro by every wind of doctrine.” It is naive and presumptuous to believe that we cannot be misled without the necessary training and mentoring of more mature and seasoned Christians who have the love and concern for us. That is why we need to be in a discipleship program and in a cell group.

Let us humble ourselves, be teachable and open to the fact that we need to learn and understand more. We pray and charge all WAC members to commit themselves to WDT or its equivalent and develop spiritual eyes and sensing so that we will not be easily moved and swayed by every wind of doctrine.

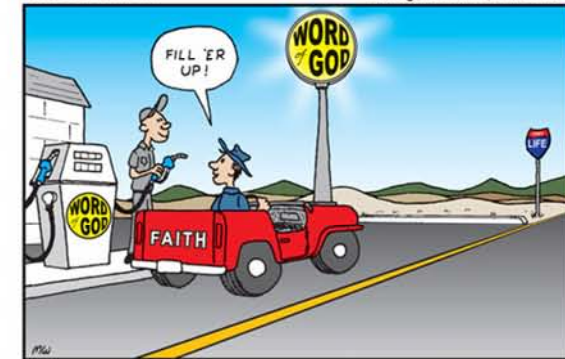
