 Pastor Raymond will be on leave from 17 December to 22 January.

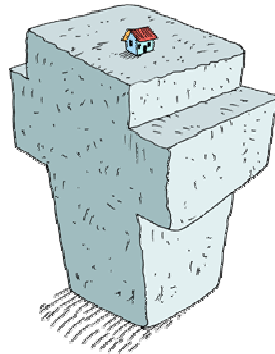

*WHAT SHOULD WE PASS ON
 TO THE NEW GENERATION?

I firmly believe this is the way we can successfully pass on our faith to a new generation. May He truly bless us not only in our life time but also into the second, third and fourth generations.
