## SEEING THE POWER OF GOD IN ACTION

How can we experience the power of God in action, moving and touching hearts and lives? The answer lies in the Gospel, or more specifically in the proclamation and sharing of the Gospel. Paul tells us in Romans 1:16, "For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek." When we preach or witness to the Gospel we give people the opportunity to experience the power of God. Whenever we share the Good News of Jesus Christ with anyone in the power of the Holy Spirit, God

moves into action. The results may be immediate or it may be gradual but the power of God has been activated in that person's life and heart. What that person needs to do is to yield in surrender and faith to allow the power to take effect in his life. When he does that the power of the Gospel will so change his life he will not be the same again. He becomes a new creation and will have the Spirit of God dwelling in him. The response must be one of repentance and belief in Christ as his Lord and Saviour.

Paul the apostle saw this many times over in his ministry. That is why he says that he is not ashamed of the gospel. The gospel is powerful and effective and not impotent. There is power in the gospel to change lives. Do we really believe that! If we do then we will be far more motivated to share the Good News with all who we know. Many need to hear and thus be given the opportunity to be touched by God.

The message is indisputably powerful. What is needed is a messenger who is empowered and willing. Are you willing to allow God to use you? Are you fearful? Are you ashamed? Have you not experienced how lives were changed and touched when the Gospel was shared with them?
