STAYING ON COURSE

WAC commenced our discipleship training in a serious way last year with the aim of showing what it truly means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. This year we are moving into step two – teaching you how to make disciples or how to be a disciple. In John 15:16, Jesus said, “You did not choose me but I chose you, and appointed you that you would go and bear fruit, and that your fruit would remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give it to you.” One does not really become a disciple until he or she has learned and successfully made another disciple through personal witnessing and follow-up. WAC’s discipleship movement is aimed at making every member a fruit-bearing follower of Jesus Christ. This is the only way the church will be able to fulfil the Great Commission. Our emphasis and focus should be soul-winning, discipling and multiplication. We reproduce ourselves so to speak in the power of the Holy Spirit and in obedience to His Word and commandments.

WAC is not interested in merely conducting church services although that is one of the things we do. We do not want to build a church where members feel all they are “obligated” to do is to attend church services, worship, put in some offering and off they go. Jesus never ever intended to build a church like that.

Therefore I strongly urge everyone to seriously consider getting into the discipleship movement. I call it a movement because it is more than just a programme. Get into the WDT teaching programme, the cell groups, the personal evangelism training that we will conduct this year and start believing that God in 2010 will give you at least one convert that you will disciple until he or she starts to also win another soul and start discipling that person till that person in turn wins another soul and disciple him or her.

We are going to be very focused and disciplined this year to encourage, facilitate and empower everyone to become a fruit-bearing disciple. Let us stay on course and on track. The "harvest truly is plentiful but the labourers are few". Everyone must commit themselves to be a labourer. A soul-winner is a labourer. As more labourers are engaged in soul-winning, the greater will be the harvest.

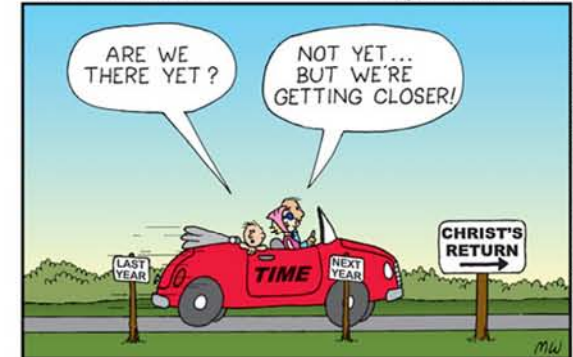
