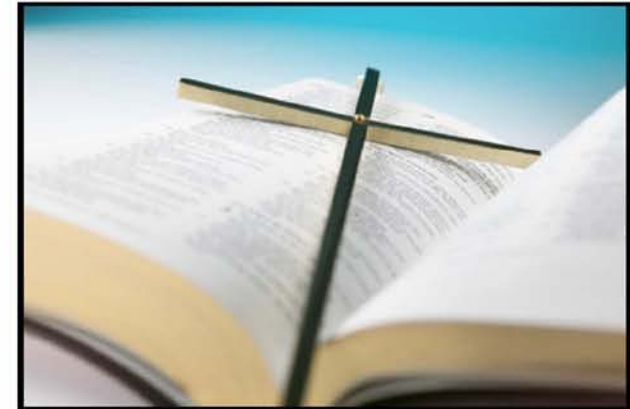

RE-DEFINING WHAT WE MEAN BY EVANGELISM

Later this year, in July, WAC together with SAC will be launching an evangelism training. This is in line with our firm conviction that all churches should stress on being evangelistic and aim at winning people into the kingdom thereby growing the church even numerically.

When we talk and think about evangelism we must re-define what we mean by *evangelism*. Most of us have been taught that "evangelism is "proclaiming the good news and inviting others to trust Christ." Yet, a valuable element is missing in that definition. We need to recognise that the missing element is that evangelism is a process. The apostle Paul said, "I planted, Apollos watered it, but God made it grow." (1 Corinthians 3:6). In many of our personal experience, we may have to plant many spiritual seeds for a period of time before someone will seriously consider the person of Christ. We may have to till the ground before we have the opportunity to plant a seed. We are not called to bring all persons to Christ but simply to bring Christ to all persons. David Giesler said, "Evangelism is every day and in every way helping your non-believing friends to take one step closer to Jesus Christ."

What we therefore need to appreciate and understand is that many of what we do in evangelism is actually pre-evangelism. What is pre-evangelism? If evangelism is planting seeds of the gospel, then pre-evangelism is *tilling the soil of people's minds and hearts to help them to be more willing to listen to the truth* (1 Corinthians 3:6).

This is what we are doing in our involvement in BB, GB and the schools drop-in centres etc. This is also what WWF has all along been aiming to do. In the launch today "Fit for the King" WWF is working toward mobilizing all women in WAC to be fit in order to be used by God to be in kingdom work of evangelism and pre-evangelism.

Let us not be too narrow-minded or impatient and simply shoot for the quick and swift results in evangelism. Be willing as the Lord directs to do tilling, sowing and certainly reaping and harvesting when opportunities arise. What is important is that we are ready, obedient and faithful to the task the Lord lays upon our hearts.

So let us, WAC, arise and together consecrate ourselves to be FIT for the Master as we prepare to do whatever He gives us to do. May He grant us success through the power of the Holy Spirit. Some plant, some sow, some reap. Let everyone be faithful in that particular task God has given.
