## KEY LESSONS FROM THE SERMON ON THE MOUNT

- PASTOR TIMOTHY CHOW -

In his longest recorded sermon, Jesus began by describing the traits he was looking for in his followers. He called those who lived out those traits "blessed" because God had something special in store for them. Each beatitudes is an almost direct contradiction of society's typical way of life. In the last beatitudes, Jesus pointed out that a serious effort to develop these traits would create opposition. Jesus gives us the best example of each trait. If our goal is to become like him, the Beatitudes will challenge the way we live each day.

## WAC ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2010

### ELECTORAL ROLL

The Electoral Roll determines those who are eligible to either vote or be elected at the AGM onto the Parochial Church Council (PCC). Baptized members who are at least 17 years of age, confirmed in the Anglican Church, and regularly attending Service and partaking Holy Communion in WAC, should be on the Electoral Roll.

### NEW APPLICATION

The Electoral Roll is available at the Admin Counter. Please check if your name is on the Roll. If your name is not on the Electoral Roll, kindly approach Gladys or Priscilla.

### NOMINATION OF OFFICE BEARERS

This AGM will be electing the following:

- (1) The People's Warden
- (2) 8 members of Parochial Church Council

Please note that Article 1.5 of the Constitution: Candidates for election to PCC shall be on the Electoral Roll of the Parish and must be nominated by writing from one member and seconded by another to the Honorary Secretary AT LEAST EIGHT (8) DAYS prior to the AGM Meeting subject to prior written consent to nomination by the candidate. Nomination forms are available at the Admin Counter for members on the Electoral Roll who wish to stand for nomination forms by **10 April 2010**.
